Prices have risen about 25% more than they have been in the past, we will be having less events this year, so it may even out moreso. Want to be fair with budgets so ask if you need something.

February Mothers luncheon, what is budget for these events -- the budgets are set at the beginning of the year-- we don't know what the events will look like so its' hard to know what the budgets will look like, so ask and it can mostly be worked out.
