IMPORTANT REMINDER: Label all personal items with your child's name (supplies, lunch bags, water bottles, etc.)

- Bring a picture of yourself (student) on the first day of school
- 5 yellow #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 1 white eraser
- 2 large (1.27 oz. size) glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 6-inch ruler
- 1 large, zippered pencil bag or large ziplock bag
- 1 small pencil sharpener with self-contained shavings holder (**NOT** battery-operated)
- 1 set of 8-count, washable, **thin**, classic-colored Crayola markers or similar brand (taken out of the box before coming to school)
- 1 set of 24 colored pencils (taken out of the box before coming to school)
- 2 highlighters yellow or pink only
- 6 black & white-spotted, wide-ruled, 100-page composition books
- 1 dual-pocket folder with child's name on it and labeled "Spanish" (Please no file folders, envelope folders, etc.)
- 1 plastic, accordion organizer (non-fabric, expandable folder)
